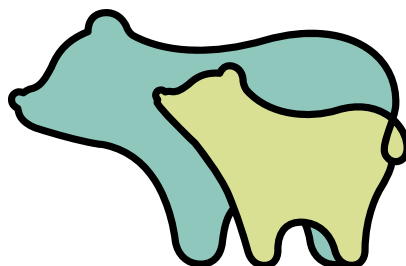

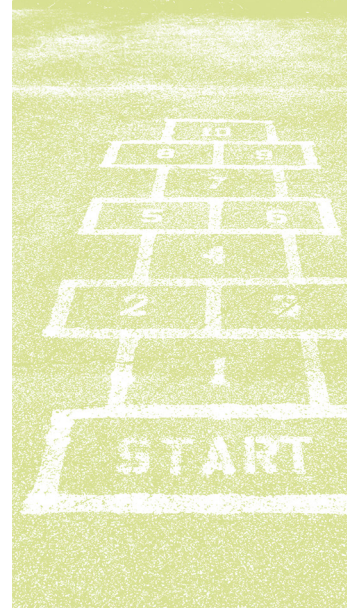

# Our Impact



## **VIP TOTS AWARDED “BEST PRESCHOOL” BY THE RIVERSIDE PRESS ENTERPRISE**

The Press Enterprise awarded VIP Tots the “Best Preschool” in 2018-2019. We continue to offer programs to children and families that best meet their individual needs. This comes in a variety of ways including behavioral intervention. We continue to receive referrals year-round from other preschools in the area who seek to place children in need of behavioral intervention.

Offering children a quality childcare setting is at the top of the list of our main goals and we strive daily to accomplish that. Our staff are highly trained and knowledgeable in the arena of child development and special education. Many of our staff have been with us for more than 10 years, and they each are highly committed to their job. Our unique programs and qualified staff continue to distinguish us as the “Best Preschool” year in and year out.

# Where We Invested

## HOME BASED INTERVENTIONS

This past year, VIP Tots served an average of 75 children per month through Home Based Interventions. This employed 10 dedicated Home Program Teachers who travelled to Beaumont, Lake Elsinore, Hemet, Menifee, Moreno Valley, Perris, San Jacinto, and all the way to Sun Valley. VIP Tots believes that an early start in intervention services is critical to a child's future success in school and life.

## ADULT LEARNING PROGRAMS

Our Positive Solutions for Families six week course served 20 families this year. Training is a vital component of all of our VIP Tots programs. The PSF course teaches valuable social and emotional skills to families.

## CHILD DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS

120 children were served per month through childcare and child development programs. This need allowed us to employ 20 full-time teachers for these children. Some classrooms continued to be supported with funding from various outside agencies and grants including First 5 Riverside and the Riverside County Office of Education (RCOE).

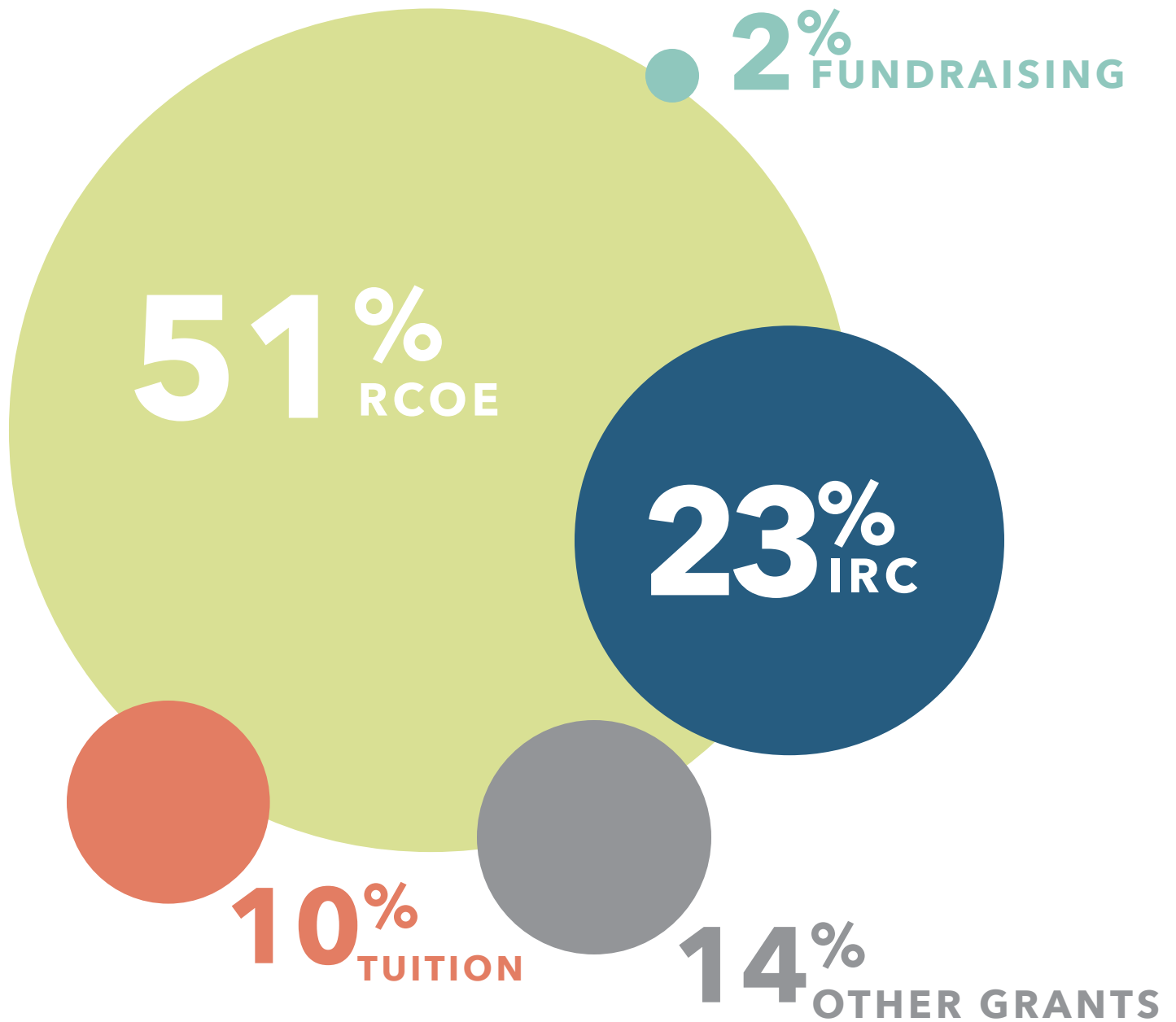
